They provided fascinating background information about the transition of Adelaide Technical High School to the Glenunga site in 1963 and the transformation into Glenunga High School ten years later.

My previous appointment was as Principal at Victor Harbor High School and prior to that, I held positions of District Superintendent in both Southern and Eastern Metro districts of Adelaide. My background is in English, Drama Counselling and Psychology.

I was delighted to be appointed to Glenunga because it is an excellent example of South Australian public education. It continues the fine traditions of academic achievement and community spirit, of history and innovations established by Adelaide Technical High School.

I am really interested in your ideas on how our current school community and the ATHS Old Scholars Association can work together to advocate strongly for public education and to support each other. We are happy to offer our facilities to the Association. Perhaps our students could provide catering and other support services for Association functions as part of their assessment requirements. Our Staff and students could share with members their international experiences.
